### **Version 2.3 EP Device Implant Registry Live:**

The NCDR is excited to announce the EP Device Implant Registry (formerly the ICD Registry) is now available for patient discharges beginning April 1, 2021. The same familiar data set with a new name now offers flexibility to collect defibrillator procedures, or novel CRT-P, His/Left Bundle, leadless pacemaker procedures, or both procedure types to support quality improvement initiatives. In addition, the registry now offers shared decision-making data capture to support CMS compliance requirements for primary prevention ICD implants.

#### **New Enhanced Dashboard:**

The enhanced dashboard is now available with the launch of the EP Device Implant Registry and will bring valuable additional benefits such as 3-year metric trend graphs, a detail line view offering filter options for easy access to information and weekly aggregation of detail line information, patient level drill down ability for select detail lines, and so much more. ### **New EP Operator Administration NPI Maintenance:**

To support the Provider Level Dashboard, there is now a new feature within the EP Operator Administration tab to help ensure the National Provider Identifier (NPI) is correctly matched to the EP Operator entered in the registry EP Operator Administration page.

To add a new provider, simply type in the NPI, click "Execute NPI" which will execute an automatic search from the CMS National Plan and Provider Enumeration System (NPPES) and the provider name matching the NPI will populate the provider name fields.
