Upcoming Call For Data Deadline Approaching on April 15th, 2021

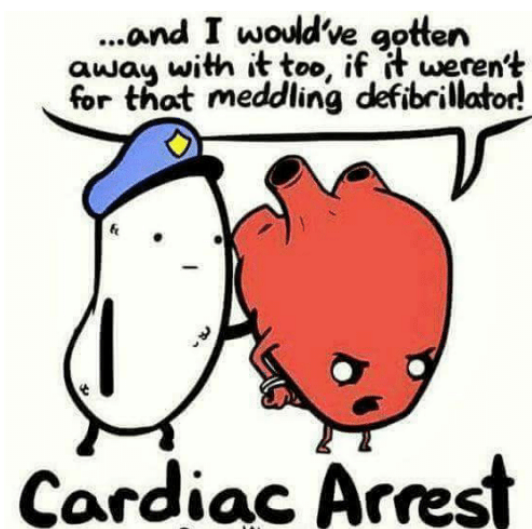
To ensure a successful Call for Data Deadline occurring on April 15th, 2021 at 11:59:59 PM Eastern Time, NCDR participants are encouraged to submit Q4 2020 (patients discharged between Oct 1st, 2020 and Dec 31st 2020) data early, and obtain a green/passing status. If your facility has no eligible patients for submission during this quarter, please proceed in submitting the quarter to confirm a zero patient quarter.
